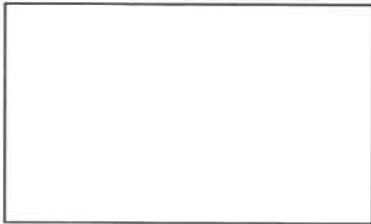

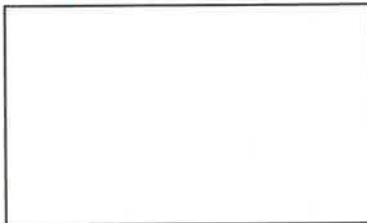
Committee Goal: Every child in Champaign County will be given the opportunity to thrive and be socially/emotionally ready to learn by school age as evidenced by universal screening efforts.

Stacey Logwood stated that there would be another training May 30 in Logan co. for anyone in the group needing trained. 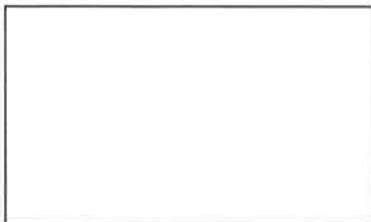
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ASQ-SE	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Group established a goal from the logic model- that they wanted to incorporate a universal screening tool county wide to ensure that we are screening all kids coming into the various preschools and agencies for social-emotional deficits. 	Missy informed group that they are making progress. E.I, Kids Learning Place, YMCA, Creative Child Care Center, and Little Strengths are all doing the ASQ-SE's. Missy working on getting Cardinal Corner, Gingerbreads, and Graham Preschool implemented on the ASQ-SE. Children Services, In Home providers, and WIC are also on the list to implement the screening tool.
Logic Model/ Strategic Plan	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Group discussed what goals they would like to work on- Creating an MOU for all the County schools, preschools and agencies- to ensure that all activities will be worked on to be completed and that there are clear expectations of what is expected. 	Stacey Logwood will send Missy examples of MOU's to use to create ECCC's MOU. Missy to bring draft to next meeting for group to review.
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Group also working on universal screenings county wide-(ASQ-SE). If a child is screened and has a high score- agencies and preschools will have parents sign release to send Missy at FCFC the information so that parents can be contacted and referrals can be made. 	FCFC will contact families, make referrals, and follow up with families to ensure that the referral was completed and services started
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Data collection- Each entity from ECCC will be keeping data on their own screening results. Agencies agreed to complete ASQ-SE's in the Fall and Spring of each year. 	The results of those screenings will be presented in ECCC Meetings.
<p>Missy and FCFC are helping with the County Kindergarten screenings to screen the kids for social-emotional deficits, using the ASQ-SE. Triad has already been completed and was very happy with the process. Missy trying to contact the other schools. More to come.</p>
